General Maintenance

In 2012, \$11,000 was spent on the general maintenance and repair of boats and the fleet is now in good shape. The boats should only require minimal on-going maintenance.

Cox Box Replacement

Four cox boxes, chargers and microphones have been replaced.

UHS Club Rowing Club Plan Update

Aims from the 2012-13 Club Plan which have been recently been achieved include the successful Come'N'Try days for Year 7 students, promotion of rowing at the Year 7 Orientation Days, the conducting of a boat rigging workshop for coaches and interested parents, the purchase of ergo slides, encouraging coxswains to attend specialist workshops, and the organisation of a nutrition seminar to focus on the dietary needs of adolescent rowers.

Kerryn provided lots of valuable information in relation to meeting daily fuel and nutrient requirements, suitable pretraining snacks, recovery nutrition, pre-event snacks/meals, sports drinks and liquid meal supplements, fluid needs, iron levels and protein supplements. It is pleasing to see that most rowers have taken the information 'on board' and are already bringing healthier snacks and drinks to regattas.
